## Waste Transportation & Disposal

**Description:** Since 2004, SWS Environmental Services has been providing waste transportation and disposal services for a confidential environmental firm on location in Sarasota, Florida. The facility housed a machine parts manufacturing plant where beryllium-containing metals were milled, lathed, and drilled into various components. Finishing of the components included electroplating, anodizing, and ultrasonic cleaning. SWS Environmental Services was initially hired to provide four 20,000-gallon frac-tanks, four waste disposal roll-off containers, and clean drums for transportation and disposal of Investigative Derived Waste (IDW). Specifically, the work consisted of using vacuum trucks to draw liquids from the frac-tanks and then transport and dispose of the liquid. Concurrently, dirt was loaded into roll-off containers for transportation and disposal via landfill.

On average, SWS Environmental Services employs the use of vacuum trucks, storage drums, and roll-off boxes and picks up said equipment weekly, even bi-weekly on occasion, to transport off property and adequately dispose of IDW consisting of contaminated groundwater, non hazardous rinse waters, and process related wastes.. The site employs an Advanced Oxidation Process groundwater treatment system with three 1,500 pound granulated activated carbon (GAC) units. SWS Environmental Services transports and disposes of the spent GAC media. SWS Environmental Services has also deployed its personnel to respond to an emergency response job on site, and in providing this key service became the firms sole approved provider of emergency response services.
